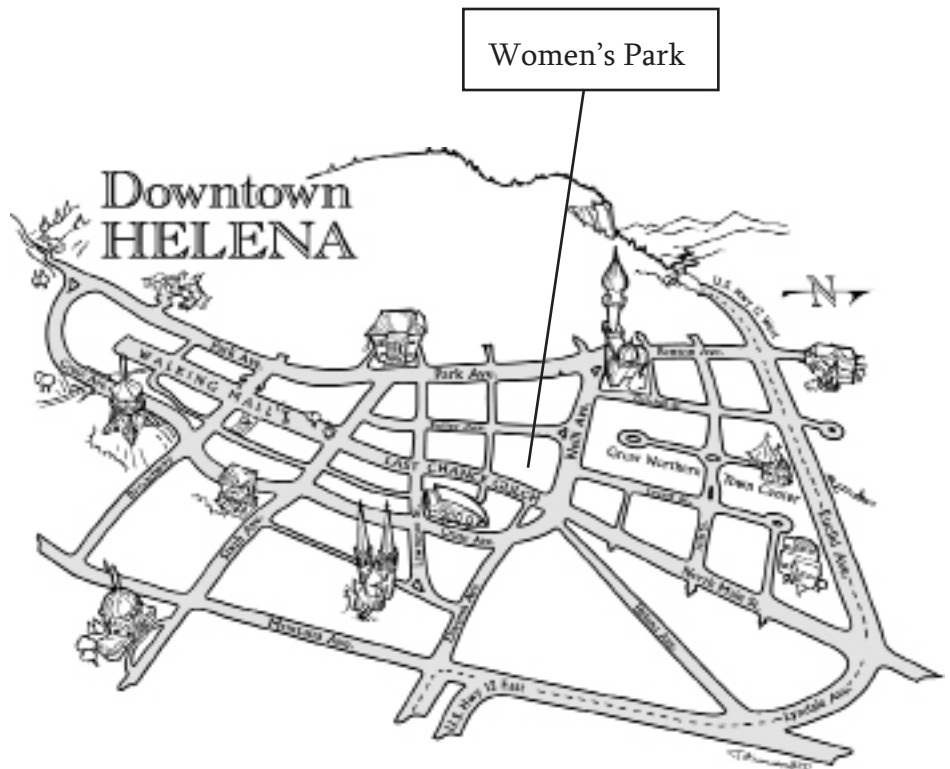

Happy Spring from Downtown Helena, Inc. (DHI)! Within weeks of warm temperatures, DHI is very excited and looking forward to a great **Art Mart** in conjunction with the **11th Annual Mount Helena Music Festival** the weekend of June 25 and 26, 2010. Once again, we learned a great deal and identified more areas from last year's event to make the program better for the exhibitors and your customers. We are committed to building the Art Mart and the Mount Helena Music Festival into one of the best festivals throughout the Northwest. The planning committee has been working hard on this year's festival and taking to heart the suggestions provided by last year's participants. Those we received were favorable and the suggestions were very helpful in planning 2010. The location will be the same as last year in the shady and centralized location at Women's Park. Our primary advertising campaign will be launched in May and continue through the festival via newsprint, posters, direct mail, TV/cable, and radio. We have numerous listings and links to our website that have seen enormous growth and usage over the past five years.

Women's Park is a large, well-shaded venue to host the event and allows us access to Hill Park if the need arises. The food vendors will be situated along Fuller Avenue to the west and the Art Mart participants will be situated on the north side of the lawn running parallel to Neill Avenue surrounding the perimeter fence for the music festival. We will provide overnight security that will patrol the grounds from 11 p.m. to 8 a.m. for Friday night.

Our attendance goal for this year is to surpass the 8,000 mark. To reach this goal, we will continue to expand our advertising campaign via TV, print and radio to include Great Falls, Butte, Bozeman, Flathead-Glacier, Missoula, Yellowstone and Jackson Hole markets. The festival is listed on the festivalfinders.com, festivals.com, festival.net, craftmaster.net, jambase.com, blues.com, and craftmasternews.com websites. We are constantly updating our website at www.downtownhelena.com on a daily basis and we accept Visa or Mastercard payments.

Hopefully your plans include being an exhibitor during the Mount Helena Music Festival Art Mart June 25-26. We are dedicated to hosting a great event while maintaining exhibitor fees and keeping admission prices low to attract a large number of all ages. Arts and Crafts Vendor Information

The **Art Mart** runs jointly with the **11th Annual Mount Helena Music Festival (MHMF)** under the ownership and supervision of Downtown Helena, Inc. Please note the following rules in order to comply with both events. **All applications will be considered on a first come-first pay basis of those submitting a completed application with payment. Please see deadlines listed below.**

Contract Terms and Rules for Art Mart Exhibitors

- Booth fee is \$100 per space if received or postmarked by June 12, 2010. \$125 after June 12.
- Approximate size per space is 10' x 10'. Larger areas will be billed at \$1.00 per square foot.
- The Mount Helena Music Festival Committee and Art Manager reserve the right to assign all spaces and display areas and their decisions remain final. Safety, fire, and traffic flow are key factors in making assignments and for the best of the show.
- Exhibitors must furnish their own display table and the equipment necessary to set-up.
- The Art Mart is an outdoor show. Exhibitors may want to bring things to protect their work from the elements (i.e. wind, rain and hail), if it becomes necessary. All tents/canopies must be free-standing units.
- At the registration table, exhibitors must sign a waiver if keeping tent/canopy/equipment/merchandise up overnight.
- The Art Mart and the Mount Helena Music Festival reserve the right to refuse space to any exhibitor.
- All food vendors must contact Downtown Helena, Inc. at (406) 447-1535 to receive the proper application and permits to sell any edible items during the festival weekend.
- Booth space is limited to a specific number of vendors and site selection will be based upon postmark date of completed application and pay basis. We will do our best to accommodate your preference, but are not making any guarantee. We will also do our best to separate vendors selling similar products. ***We are hoping to concentrate vendors in spaces 1-34, so please note this fact as you make your selection.***

Sidewalk Art Mart Schedule: June 25-26, 2010

Registration and Set-up:	Friday, June 25	7:30 a.m. to 12 noon
Sale Hours:	Friday, June 25	12 noon to 8 p.m.
	Saturday, June 26	9 or 10 a.m. to 8 p.m.
Farmers' Market Hours:	Saturday, June 26	9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

These hours are the only officially recognized and advertised hours by the MHMF. Exhibitors must be set up prior to the sale hours. Booths are allowed to stay open later if the exhibitor chooses to do so at their own discretion!

Security

The Mount Helena Music Festival and the Art Mart will provide overnight security for the general area from 11 p.m. to 8 a.m. the evening of Friday, June 25. However, each exhibitor assumes all responsibility for equipment, merchandise and belongings left out overnight. The park area is too large to provide maximum security during the off hours and MHMF cannot be responsible for any loss, theft or damage caused by individual(s), weather or unforeseen circumstances.

Vehicles

NO vehicles will be permitted to enter or drive onto the park lawn. Loading access will be made available on Neill Avenue from 7 a.m. to noon on Friday, June 25. Each vendor must unload and move their vehicles to insure all exhibitors have the opportunity to unload near the park.

Check-in and Registration will take place under the Arch in Women's Park (corner of Neill and Fuller Avenues) on Friday June 25, from 7:30 a.m. to noon. Space assignments, parking permits, festival passes and other information will be provided at the registration time only.

The fees and deadlines are as follows:

Early Registration Fee - Received or postmarked by June 12 - \$100

Late Registration Fee - Received or postmarked after June 12 - \$125
